Truth: God loves you. He always has and He always will. God loves you no matter what you've done or what you are doing. He loves you whether you are a good person or the meanest, nastiest, most messed-up person alive. You can't stop God from loving you.

What God says:

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

John 3:16

God told them, "I've never quit loving you and never will. Expect love, love, and more love!"

Jeremiah 31.3 MSG

In this the love of God was made manifest (displayed) where we are concerned: in that God sent His Son, the only begotten or unique [Son], into the world so that we might live through Him.

I John 4:9 AMP

Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us. The angels cried, “Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward men!” Love gives unconditionally with no strings attached. God, in love, sacrificed His only Begotten Son for you. He allowed His Son, Jesus, to be tortured and to suffer a cruel death on the cross as a substitute for you. He, Himself, perfect and without sin, paid the penalty for your sin. So great is His love that He did that even before you were born, knowing the mistakes you would make and the sins you would commit. He did that out of love for you. You can curse His name and reject Him, but you can’t make Him not love you. Make no mistake, God does not like sin, but He loves the sinner. No matter where you are in life, never doubt God’s love for you. You can never run too far

from God. He is always waiting with open arms waiting to gently squeeze you in a love-filled bear hug.

Confession: God loves me! The Creator of the universe loves me! I know He loves me because He allowed Jesus, His only Begotten Son, to die for me knowing beforehand the sins I would commit. He loved me even before I confessed Him as Lord and Savior. Lord, thank You for loving me. You are compassionate and gracious, abounding in love and faithfulness. I trust in Your unfailing love and rejoice in Your salvation. I run into Your open arms and drink deeply of Your love. Please help me comprehend the fullness of the love You have for me. Lord, make me an instrument of love; filled with Your love and sharing that love with others. I receive Your love. Thank you, my Father.
